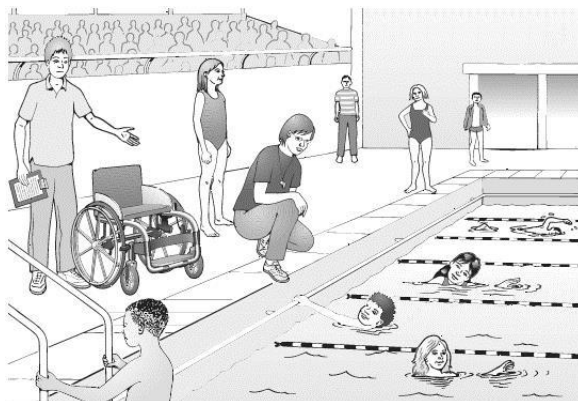

Emily, Ben and Nisha take part in a sponsored swim to collect money for charity.


Emily collects £2.75 **more** than Nisha.
